

Emergency School Closing

All parents are asked to please keep the following in mind concerning emergency school closures:

1. School will remain in session in most circumstances.
2. Parents may choose to keep their child home if the weather constitutes a threatening situation for the child.
3. School administrators will ask for parental support in making arrangements for the students living in rural areas to stay in town.
4. KTGA-Bigfoot 99 (FM), KRAI (Craig), and K2 radio and television will provide information to patrons concerning early dismissal or cancellation. A school messenger will be sent out as well calling all parents/guardians.
5. The responsibility for early dismissal or school cancellations is that of the Superintendent.

Cold Weather Protocol

We understand that extreme cold is dangerous. Parents know that also. It is the parent's decision to decide whether it is safe for their individual circumstances to allow their child to stand at a bus stop. Some are too young and some families cannot provide the cold weather clothing that is required. In those cases a parent should not put their child in danger. The district does not count tardies or absences as unexcused in circumstances of extreme cold. The bottom line is that the superintendent decides whether school will open or not based on recommendations from transportation personnel; and the parents decide (based on their individual circumstances) whether their child will come and at what time. Unless the roads are not safe a nice warm school will be open for all families who can get their child to school at the regular time; which is most of the parents.
