

**CCSD#1 Virtual Networking Alternative (Permission)**

Virtual Networking Alternatives: It is recognized that virtual networking options can be a valuable instructional approach. Since the requirements in Policy GBEBB paragraph “Technology 1.” require parent approval; any staff member who wishes to start a networking account for a class project, club, sport, etc. *outside of the social networking sites* described are required to obtain written permission from a principal, assistant principal, or the superintendent. Any approval shall require some form of notice of such networking to the parent or guardian of the student. *Permission does not authorize inappropriate communications.* In addition the following shall apply to approved networking sites:

- (a) When adding photos select the option “do not share photos” unless there is a clear educational purpose, it is a family member or the staff member has parental permission.
- (b) Do not “tag” your photos with your name or the names of others. Tagging photos means listing the people in the photos by name, either partial or full. “Tagged” photos automatically link to others’ sites.
- (c) Keep blogging work friendly. Do not use names of co-workers, bosses, or students when expressing educationally related opinions.
- (d) Do not give out personal information.
