## Process for Paraeducator to become Substitute Certified

- 1. Paraeducators are required to take the Carbon County School District #1 Substitute Training classes to become a certified substitute.
- 2. Make sure fingerprints and background check information has been obtained through the Human Resource Department.
- 3.30 hours of observations are required (10 at each level).
  - a. Set up required observations with principals at the high school, middle school and elementary school levels.
  - b. Before you observe, permissions must be obtained from your immediate principal and supervisor, as well as the school in which you are doing the observations.
  - c. Track your observation hours on the attached log.
- 4. Make sure this process is done immediately. You will have 6 weeks to complete observations.
- 5. After you have completed 30 hours of observations and the Substitute Training classes, you must turn in all documentation to the Human Resource department to be sent in to PTSB.
